

PVLL YOUTH UMPIRE PROGRAM AGREEMENT

The Palos Verdes Little League (PVLL) Youth Umpire Program is intended to increase participant's knowledge of the rules of the game, build character and foster continued youth involvement. The ultimate goal of this program is to give youth an opportunity to learn, succeed and be rewarded in a challenging and safe environment.

The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure that you (and your parents) understand both the benefits and responsibilities that come with participation in PVLL's Youth Umpire Program. As a participant in the program, you are responsible for your actions on the field; as an umpire you will be responsible for controlling the actions of two teams of players, managers, and fans. That is a BIG responsibility! We want you to both be aware of this responsibility as well as PVLL's appreciation for your having accepted it.

As your sponsor, PVLL will provide you with:

- Training and support.
- PVLL Youth Umpire hat and game indicator.
- Payment for games completed and recorded.

As a Youth Umpire, you will:

- Attend both the informational rules and field mechanics trainings.
- Be responsible and accountable (i.e., show up for games you are scheduled to work)
- Pay attention to the game and make sure you are doing your job correctly and with enthusiasm.
- Work in a professional manner.
- Be dedicated and have the self-control necessary to meet the job requirements.
- Be honest and accurate to the best of your ability.
- Communicate clearly and decisively when making play decisions.
- Work cooperatively with Pro Umpires.
- Dress appropriately and bring necessary job equipment to scheduled games (PVLL Youth Umpire Hat, PVLL Youth Umpire Shirt, non-baseball logoed clothing, indicator, tennis shoes).

- Have a positive attitude.
- Follow the youth umpire rules as learned in field mechanic training(s).

Youth Umpires will umpire <u>only in the field position</u> (only Pro Umpires can be behind the plate).

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:

All youth umpires must attend PVLL Youth Umpire training each year before they can umpire games. For new umpires, the training consists of attendance at one (1) PVLL Rules Meeting for both youth and their parents, as well as one (1) Field Mechanics Training. Returning umpires must attend one (1) Fields Mechanics Training.

PVLL Field Mechanics Training (Youth Only):

Note: You may choose to attend both of the field mechanics trainings should you wish, but attendance at only one is mandatory. Please wear tennis shoes, your PVLL Youth Umpire hat, and bring your indicator with you.

LOCATION: Valmonte Field

Should you not be able to make a scheduled training due to illness or other emergency, contact the PVLL Youth Umpire Coordinator immediately to make other training arrangements. (NOTE: Dates/times of trainings subject to change based on venue and trainer availability)

SCHEDULING GAMES:

The PVLL Youth Umpire Coordinator conducts youth umpire scheduling to ensure game coverage. Online scheduling will be conducted to ensure coverage of all PVLL minor, intermediate and major games. Online scheduling requirements are to be respected and followed.

COMPENSATION:

Youth Umpires will be compensated at the rates shown below. In addition, Youth Umpires are eligible to receive one (1) hamburger or hot dog and one (1) drink from the snack shack at their scheduled game field.

Minors Game Youth Umpire.....\$20 per game Intermediate / Majors Youth Umpire.....\$25 per game

If a game is cancelled at the last minute due to weather and/or other reasons, the Youth Umpire will be compensated for their time as scheduled.

YOUTH UMPIRE GAME LOG/SIGN-IN:

In order for payment to be made, Youth Umpires MUST sign-in on the Youth Umpire Game Log in the snack shack at their game scheduled field.

YOUTH UMPIRE UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:

Youth Umpires are asked to report to their shift with the following:

- PVLL Youth Umpire Hat (lost hats can be replaced for a minimal fee)
- PVLL Youth Umpire Shirts (lost shirts can be replaced for fee)
- Non-baseball logo clothing (i.e., clothing that does not contain any baseball team/logo affixed to it)
- Game indicator
- Tennis shoes (or similar)

YOUTH UMPIRE IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS

- Youth umpires are to treat their position as a job and to be professional at all times. Youth umpires are reminded to keep to the job at hand and speak only to the Pro umpire when necessary (i.e., no excessive chatting with onfield players please)
- Youth umpires are forbidden to use cellphones during games they are working. You may keep a cellphone in your pocket, but you may not be on the phone at any time during the game.
- Youth Umpires are required to SIGN IN for their shifts in the snack shack at their assigned field.
- Youth umpires CANNOT work a game where they have a sibling playing during that game.
- It is IMPORTANT that you show up to work the games you are scheduled! IF you cannot fulfill your commitment, please contact the Youth Umpire coordinator IMMEDIATELY to ensure game coverage.
- If any Pro Umpire, manager, player or fan speaks to you inappropriately at any time during/after a game, please contact the PVLL Youth Umpire Coordinator by cell phone immediately.

PVLL YOUTH UMPIRE COORDINATOR:

To be considered for an opportunity to be a youth umpire, completed applications must be sent/turned in to the youth umpire coordinator **no later than,** Wednesday, 1/22 . Interested participants that do not have a completed application submitted by this date will be accepted on a needs basis only.

PVLL YOUTH ANNOUNCERS AGREEMENT

The Palos Verdes Little League (PVLL) is unique in our area in that we have youth announcers for each of our Valmonte games.

The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure that you (and your parents) understand both the benefits and responsibilities that come with participation in PVLL's Announcer Program. As a participant in the program, you are responsible for your actions at the field; as an announcer you will be representing PVLL with what you say and do. That is a BIG responsibility! We want you to both be aware of this responsibility as well as PVLL's appreciation for your having accepted it.

As a Youth Announcer, you will:

- Follow clearly defined procedures and youth announcer rules without exception.
- Attend all required youth announcer trainings.
- It is IMPORTANT that you show up to work the games you are scheduled! IF you cannot fulfill your commitment, please contact the Youth Announcer coordinator IMMEDIATELY by cell phone to ensure game coverage. Contact Mrs. Eroen at (310) 990-2873 ASAP if unable to work scheduled shift.
- Be responsible and accountable (i.e., show up for games you are scheduled to work)
- Pay attention to the game and make sure you are doing your job correctly and with enthusiasm.
- Work in a professional manner with a positive attitude.
- Be dedicated and have the self-control necessary to meet the job requirements.
- Arrive 30 minutes before start of the scheduled game.
- Speak clearly and make an effort to be sure you are heard and understood.
- Play appropriate music of your choosing before and after games and between innings.
- Will <u>not</u> play music containing profanity, sexual or inappropriate content.

- Select music most likely to appeal to the audience (parents, players, other spectators) and use music to create a positive, energetic environment at the Valmonte field.
- SIGN IN for their shifts in the snack shack at their assigned field.
- Youth announcers will work alone this year only the announcer will be allowed in the booth at all times– no exceptions.
- Keep announcer door closed and keep loiters around the ladder out.
- Will not unplug or remove any equipment from the announcing booth.
- Will keep AUX chords away from tower doors.
- Will obtain lineups from each team manager. Read each player's name out load to manager or scorekeeper for correct pronunciation.
- Will adhere the numbered name-plate to corresponding Senate Seat.
- Will play music before, between innings, after games.
- Will announce the pitcher, catcher and the score at the start of each inning.
- Will announce the name of every player coming at to bat.
- Will stay after game, keep music playing, while attending to closing duties. On Saturdays, stay until the next announcer arrives for his/her game.
- Will collect Senate Seat name plates and return to plastic container in booth.
- Will discard trash from booth.
- Will close tower doors, lock booth, and return key to snack shack.

PVLL YOUTH ANNOUNCER MINIMUM AGE & EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

If you are interested in being a Youth Announcer you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. You play(ed) for PVLL, are 13 years of age AND in 7th grade or older, fulfilled training and shadowed an Announcer. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2. You possess individual responsibility and accountability.
- 3. You possess the dedication and self-control necessary to meet the job requirements.
- **4.** Have a completed Youth Announcer Agreement, on file with the PVLL Youth Announcer Coordinator.
- 5. You are able to attend all associated training sessions.
- 6. All announcers must have an iPod or compatible MP3 player and the ability to create a file of appropriate, upbeat game day music.

SCHEDULING GAMES:

The PVLL Youth Announcer Coordinator conducts scheduling to ensure game coverage. Online scheduling will be conducted to ensure coverage of all PVLL games at Valmonte Field. Online scheduling requirements are to be respected and followed.

COMPENSATION:

Youth Announcers will be compensated at the rate shown below. In addition, Youth Announcers are eligible to receive one (1) hamburger or hot dog and one (1) drink from the snack shack at their scheduled game field (if snack shack is in operation).

Youth Announcer.....\$25 per game

If a game is cancelled at the last minute due to weather and/or other reasons, the Youth Announcer will be compensated for their time as scheduled.

YOUTH ANNOUNCER GAME LOG/SIGN-IN:

In order for payment to be made, Youth Announcers MUST sign-in on the Youth Announcer Log located in the snack shack.

YOUTH ANNOUNCER TRAINING:

Youth announcer training for all new announcers will be on **Sunday**, January 26th at 11 am at Valmonte. All those new to the program should plan to attend. All new announcers will also shadow an experienced announcer prior to announcing on their own. (NOTE: Date/time of training subject to change)

PVLL YOUTH ANNOUNCER COORDINATOR:

To be considered for an opportunity to be a youth announcer, completed applications must be **sent/turned in to the youth announcer coordinator no later than** W**ednesday**, Jan. **22**, **2025** Interested participants that do not have a completed application submitted by this date will be accepted on a needs basis only.
